

NET SCRIPT FOR THE SAMMAMISH ARES/RACES GROUPE NET

Precede the net at 5 minutes before net time with: This is (CALLSIGN). We will be conducting the City of Sammamish ARES/RACES Net on this frequency in approximately 5 minutes.

At net time:

QST, QST, QST! This is W7SRG, the City of Sammamish ARES/RACES Net. Your net control station for this evening's net is (NAME), {CALLSIGN}. This net meets every Sunday night at 1900 hrs Pacific time on this repeater, 441.550 MHz with a tone of 103.5 Hz. This net meets for the purpose of handling traffic, disseminating information relative to the group, for training, station testing and optimization. The primary frequency in an actual emergency is this repeater, with 147.560 MHz simplex as a secondary.

<Drop Carrier (DC)>

This is a directed net. When giving your callsign, please do so phonetically, and do not transmit until directed to do so by Net Control. Stations with Emergency or Priority Traffic are allowed to break in at any time. Is there any Emergency or Priority Traffic at this time?

<DC>

We will now begin the City of Sammamish ARES/RACES Groupe Net roll call. Please respond with:

Your Callsign phonetically

Your Name

If you are operating on portable or emergency power

and whether or not you have any traffic or bulletins for the net.

If you hear any station respond that is not recognized by Net Control, please note the callsign of that station, and hold until Net Control asks for any relays.

(NOTE: be sure and acknowledge each response by their call and name)

<Drop Carrier (note: drop carrier after each callsign for at least 5 seconds or more to allow stations to respond.)>
